Club Rules

- You are to arrive 15 minutes before the session starts to help set up and stay after 12pm in order to help put away.
- You have to ensure that the field is set up before setting up your own equipment and you also have to put field equipment away before your own equipment.
- Juniors are able to help with setting up and packing away of the equipment if safe and able to do so with the exception of the boss's and there must be 2 juniors to a stand.
- GNAS Rules of Shooting have to be abided by without exception.
- If you are unable to pay for your session you are unable to shoot.
- People are able to have, a have a go session at a price of £5.
- If any member of the club does not abide by the rules the committee have the right to ask the member to leave the club, however the member has the right to appeal this decision.
- We will take on juniors as young as the age of 5 provided they are accompanied by an adult up to the age of 8.
- The shooting line has to remain clear at all times.
- General housekeeping rules have to be abided by at all times.
- There has to be a field captain at all times on the shooting line which has to be a member of the committee or a coach.
- There has to be 2 adult members of GNAS present at all times when shooting is in progress.
- We should have no more than six arrows per quiver at any one time.
- Arrows have to be signed in and out when in use.
- Everyone has to help to set up and pack away when we host a competition.
